Things to do in revision groups

- Check that your lecture notes are complete: other people may have understood lecture or seminar information differently. You may find you misheard or misunderstood an aspect of the subject.
- Check whether you all share the same understanding of the subject: are there areas where you disagree?
- Decide how to lay out the material for a complex topic in an easy-tounderstand chart or diagram.
- Debate the issues that are current for your subject.
- Summarise key aspects of each major theory.
- Summarise differences between the main schools of thought for your subject.
- Go over past exam questions together: see how quickly you can identify the main points of each answer.
